- (b)(5) page 5 – entire overview – “Under this initiative, OJJDP expects successful applicants to develop or enhance mentoring service models and mentor training based on best practices to focus on the needs of girls and boys, including lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and questioning (LGBTQ) youth, who are at risk or are victims of CSE/DST; develop or update strategies to recruit and maintain mentors to serve unidentified and underserved populations; begin or enhance efforts to identify and enroll girls, boys, and LGBTQ youth who are in need of services; and provide needed services to these youth.” (b)(5)
